

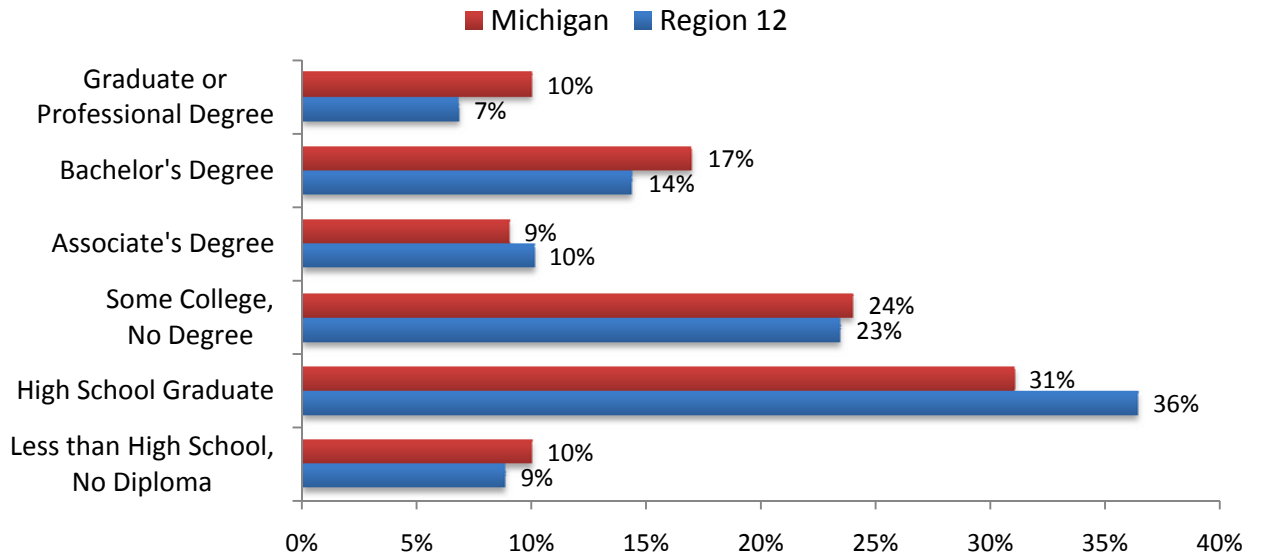

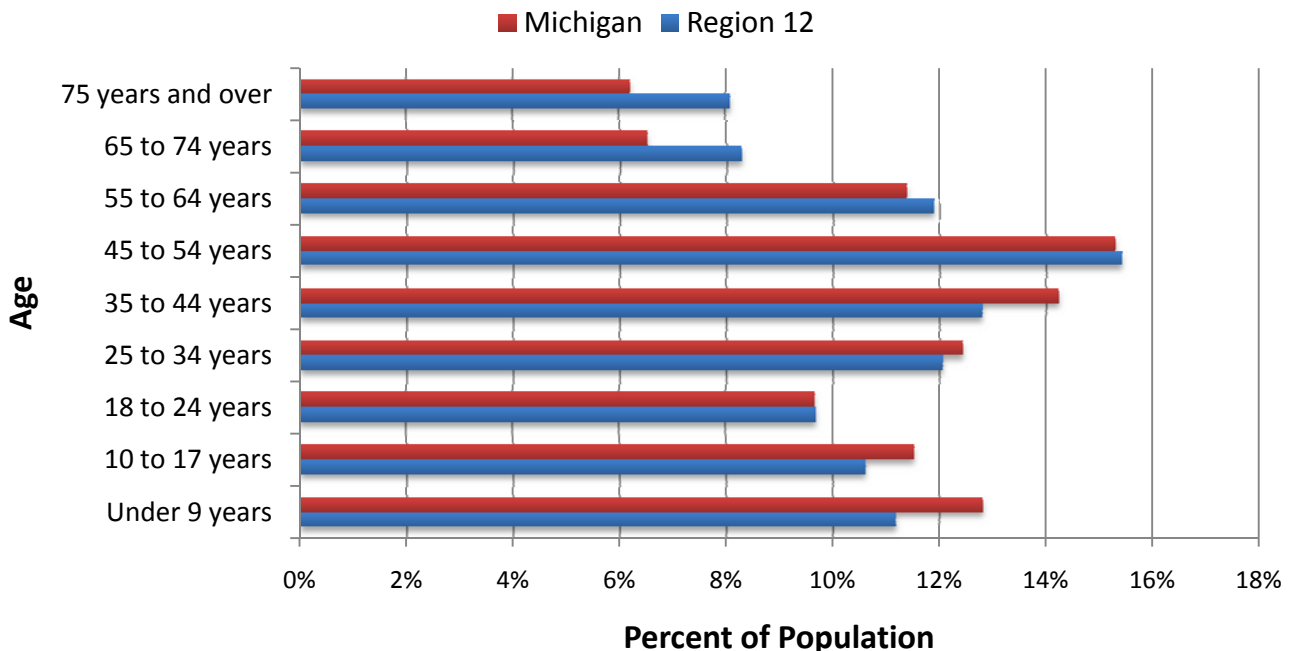
**Highest Educational Attainment for Individuals Ages 25-64:

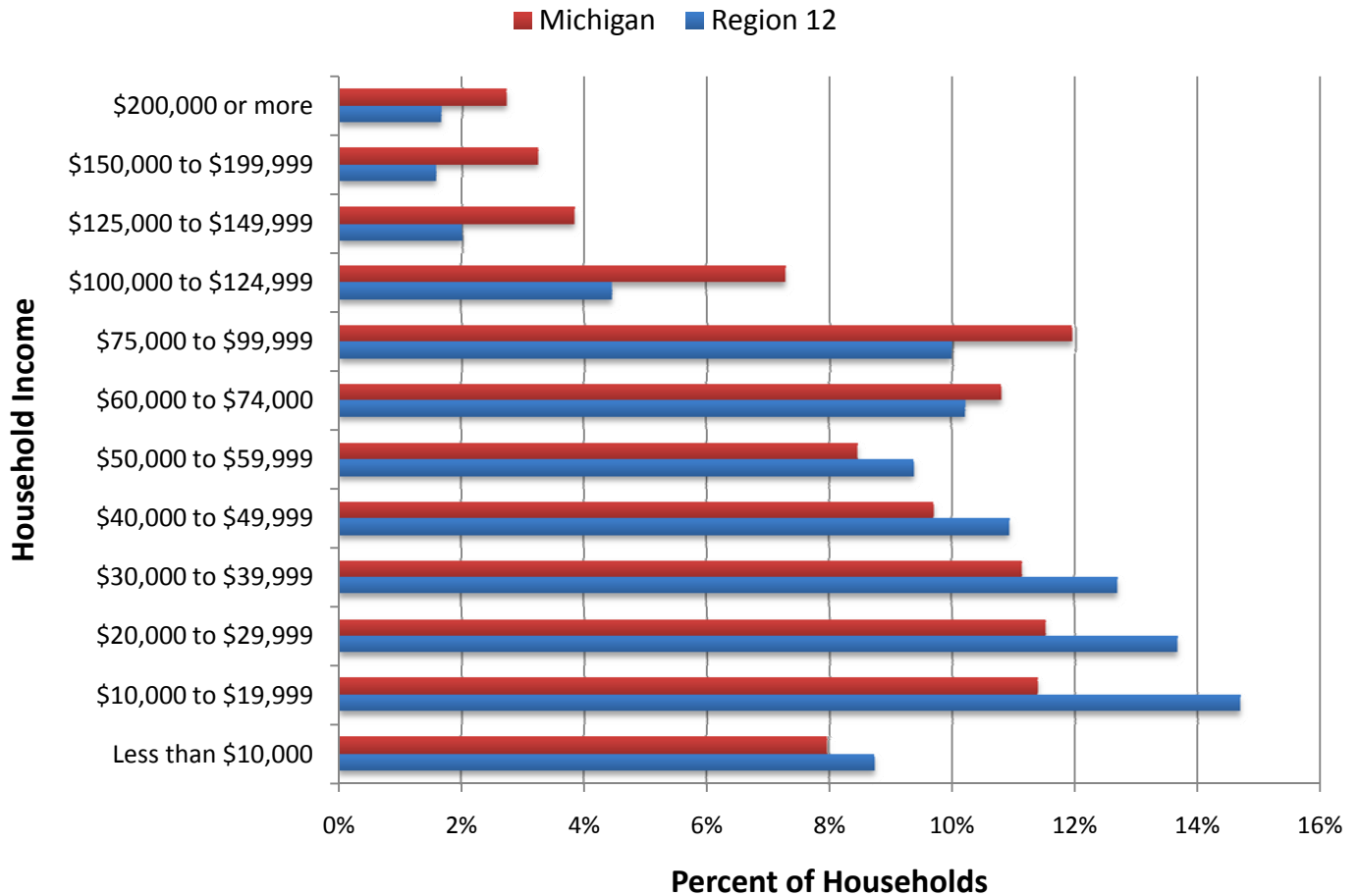
